

OSSTF - Priority Planning:

Highest Priority: Requires immediate federal or provincial legislative or regulatory attention and require major resources on the Federation's part.

- Liberal Report Card
- Restructuring of Special Education\ Influence Review of
- Structured Consultations within the Federation
- Organization of Politically Active Teachers
- Plan of Action for the 2007 Election

Priority: Is important to the OSSTF – Activities to be determined as opportunities and available resources permit.

- Reduction of Class Size - 6\8 (*Second Floor Priority*)
- Job Security (*Second Floor Priority*)

Monitoring – Is relevant to the OSSTF, but will be acted upon only when specific opportunities arise, or conditions change member needs and priorities

- Improved Success in Applied Level Programs
- P3 Schools and Privatization

Planning – Requires a concerted planning effort in order to develop specific objectives that can be prioritized and acted upon.

- Better and Greater Use of Technology (Process Priority)
- Research and Evaluation (Process Priority)
- Institute a Consultation Process for OSSTF Members to Assist in the Development of Departmental Long-Term Plans.
